**Promoters Conditions**



1. The promoter is the Nottinghamshire A.S.A.
2. All communication will be electronic via the website [www.notts-swimming.co.uk](http://www.notts-swimming.co.uk) or email as appropriate.
3. The competition is open to swimmers who are members of any Swim England Club.
4. All events are 'Open' with mixed ages, but results and awards will be issued in each age band: 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15/Over.
5. Awards not collected on the day will be forfeited.
6. All events will be seeded in time order with the last heat of each event spearheaded.
7. The 400m Freestyle events may be limited on heats depending on overall session running time.
8. Although there are no qualification times for this competition, entrants must submit a time for entry, but be lower than our upper limit times as published to be accepted for this competition.
9. Entries must be submitted by the club gala coordinator who is responsible for entering the swims electronically using the Sportsystems Entry Manager Program.
10. Entry times should be short course times, or long course converted using the SportSystems conversion.
11. Entries received and processed will be listed on the website as they are received.
12. Entries are welcome from Para-Swimmers. Entry times must be submitted for the purposes of seeding but the times do not need to meet any qualifying standards. Para-Swimmers swim inclusive within the able bodied programme and seeded on their entry time. The decision to accept such entries will be at the discretion of the promoter. There will be no para specific awards for this meet.
13. The club gala coordinator is responsible for communicating with the swimmers, checking the processed entries and reporting any problems or errors to the gala administrator within 1 week of the closing date.
14. Swimmers who wish to withdraw from events must notify the gala administrator no later than the start of the warm up for events in that session. This can be done by using the online withdrawal form.
15. Withdrawals made after the closing date will not be entitled to a refund.
16. The promoter reserves the right to limit entries should the gala capacity be exceeded. The meet is a first come first served meet and entries will be taken until we are full on time and then only on a one by one basis to fill all lanes.
17. Any question arising, for which these conditions do not provide, shall be determined by the promoter.
